Pre-requisites, evening study and examinations

Delegates should have some experience of projects. Pre-course materials are issued before the course, requiring around twenty hours of self-study. Some evening work is required during the course. Delegates take a 1 hour multiple choice Foundation paper on the third day and on passing this are eligible to sit the 2 ½ hour Practitioner Objective Test Examination (OTE) on the fifth day.

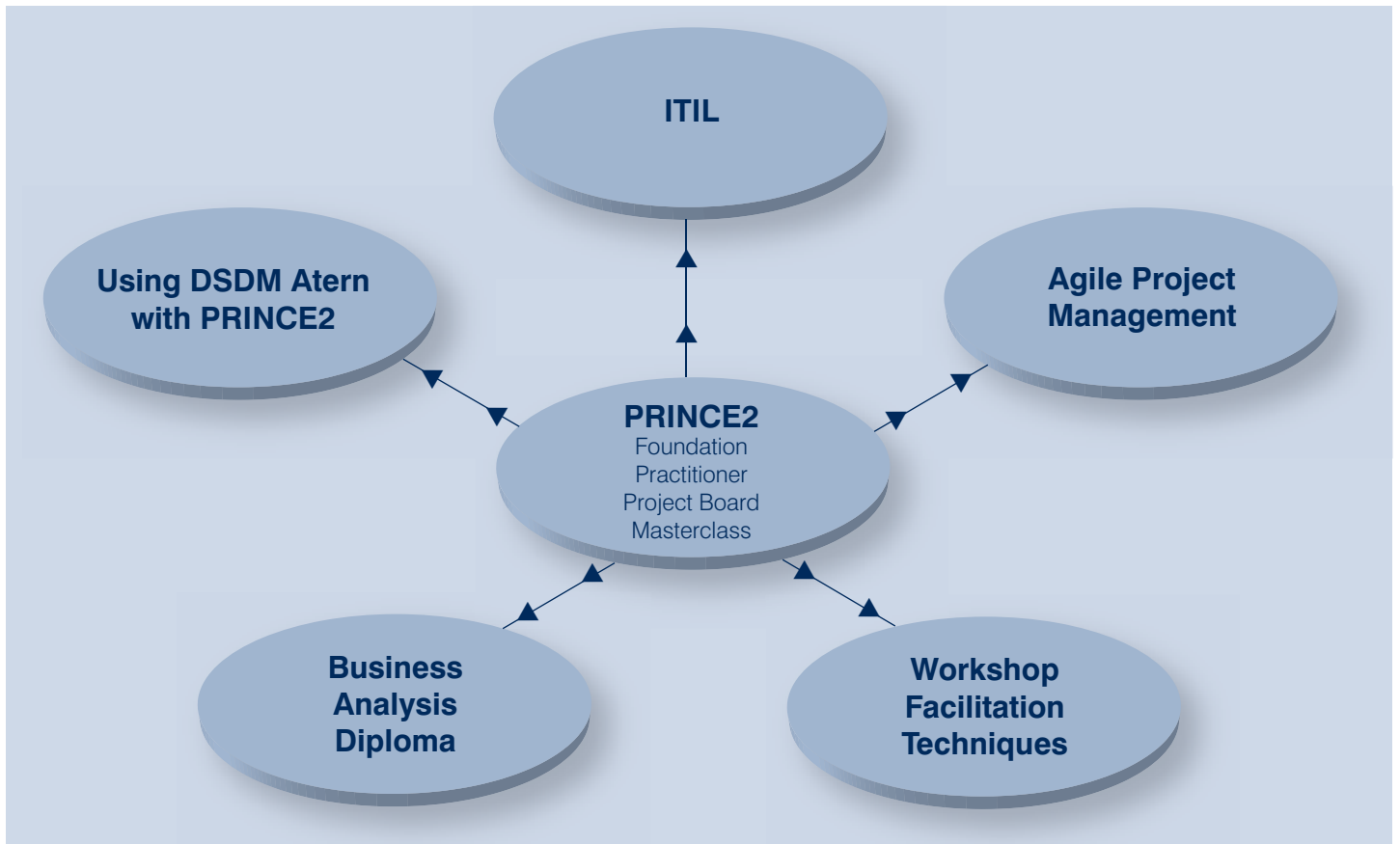
